

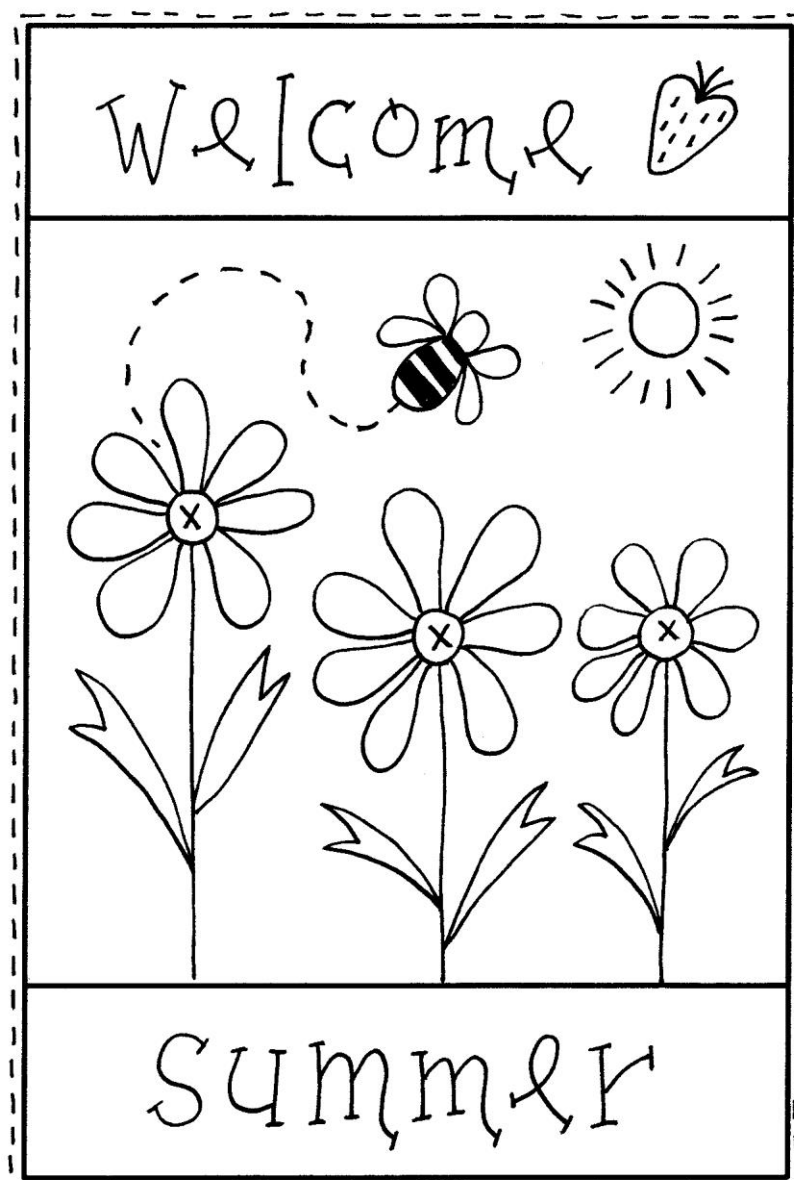
Welcome Summer

Cut your background fabric at 7" x10".

Transfer the design using your preferred method.

If desired, back with a light weight fusible interfacing.

Use Weeks Dye Works thread in Raspberry (1336) to stitch as follows. All stitching is backstitch except for: the outline is stem stitch and the dashed line is running stitch..



Once you have finished stitching, trim to 5 ½" x 7 ½".

Cut two red side borders at 2 ½" x 7 ½" and sew them on. Cut a top and bottom border at 2 ½" x 9 ½" and sew to the top and bottom.

Place a piece of batting behind the top. Cut out a backing piece that is ¾" wider than the top, all the way around. Place the top and batting on top of the backing piece WRONG sides together.

Quilt with perle 8 ecru thread ¼" from the seams and a wavy line in each border (see photo)

Cut two lengths of cream ric rac 12" long and glue baste to the sides, with the ric rac right up against the edges. You only want a half of it peeking out!

Cut another two pieces 10" long and repeat for the top and bottom.

Cut a red binding strip 1 ½" x width of fabric and bind using the single fold binding method.
